

Addition to the question of the untranslated constant JLIB_INSTALLER_DEFAULT_STYLE in the JD Dallas template.

Before installing Quickstart JD Dallas (paid template), I tried to install the free QuickStart JD Chicago and JD Newjersey in XAMPP. For these two templates, the ANGIE-Akeeba Next Generation Installer Engine v.5.2.3 was used as the installer.

After unzipping the package to the site folder, I inserted the following lines into the htaccess.txt file:

```
php_value upload_max_filesize 20M
```

```
php_value post_max_size 20M
```

```
php_value max_execution_time 200
```

```
php_value max_input_time 200
```

Then save the file as .htaccess

The installation of free templates took place without problems and I received on the local server full demo versions of these templates.

If the JD Dallas template was installed, the ANGIE-Akeeba Next Generation Installer Engine v.5.2.3 was not used and for an unknown reason I received in Templates: Styles the name JLIB_INSTALLER_DEFAULT_STYLE.

On the Internet, very scant information about this problem and vague reasoning about the elimination.

It has been suggested:

- on the impact of the Admin Tools application (Akeeba)

(I have not installed it and therefore is not the cause)

- about the absence of constant translation in the file \ administrator \ language \ en-GB \ en-Gb.lib_joomla.ini

(deliberately typed in as a translation the present name of the template **shaper-helix3** - this also did not eliminate the reason)

I solved the problem with the JLIB_INSTALLER_DEFAULT_STYLE constant in this way:

- in the administrative site panel menu, I clicked on the Extension option, then Template, then Templates: Styles, clicked on the name of JLIB_INSTALLER_DEFAULT_STYLE constant

- in Templates: Edit Style - renamed the constant to **shaper_helix3 - Default**

- clicked on the Save & Close button

- **problem solved** (see attachment)
